## Discussion Topics

- 2. If the book was made into a movie, who would you cast to play each of the characters?
- 3. What was your favourite part of the book?
- 4. What did you think of the writing? Were there any sentences or passages that stood out to you?
- 5. If you could ask the author anything, what would it be?
- 6. How thought-provoking did you find the book? Did it change your opinion about anything or did you learn something new?
- 7. How did the book make you feel? Were there any parts that made you laugh, cry, cringe, feel anger or frustration, etc.?
- 8. Who is the author and how does their background relate to the book? Do you think they had a specific purpose or goal for writing it?
- 9. Did the author use any literary devices, techniques, or style to enhance their writing? To what effect?
- 10. What were the main themes/ messages of the story?
- 11. Who was your favourite character and why?
- 12. Which character did you relate to or empathize with and why?
- 13. Which character did you dislike or disagree with and why?
- 14. Did the author use any scientific or technological concepts or theories to support their story?
- 15. What does the world of the book say about our actual world? Is it optimistic or cautionary?

#### **Tea Party**

Linda Pumpernickel loves drinking tea. Have a tea party themed book club meeting. or each meeting, choose a different book club member to bring tea and/or baked goods.

#### Spü for You

Chapter 31 introduces a beverage called Spü, complete with a description from the label on the bottle. For this week's meeting, book club members can create their own drink, give it a fun name and a description, and even bring it to share with the group.

#### **Oodles of Noodles**

Oodleans love to eat noodles, perhaps due to their similarity to the woodlerms that are their natural food source on planet Oodle. Have a noodle-themed book club meeting where each member brings a different noodle dish. Alternatively, assign a member to bring a noodle dish to each meeting.
